COMPETITION JUDGING SYSTEM & COMMITTEE

PROJECTOR & JUDGING SYSTEM

Projector was a Canon SX7 using a sRGB profile. Scoring system was the Filmfree Projection (<http://filmfreeprojection.co.uk/>). Both the projector and scoring system was managed using a HP G6 laptop computer.

SETUP & PRE-TESTING

Prior to the commencement of the competition, the judge scoring pads were tested and verified as accurately recording entered scores. In addition, the projector and the screen were colour calibrated prior to the commencement of the judging process.

No sample images were projected for the judges prior to the commencement of the judging process.

Images were projected onto a white screen in front of the three judges. Each judge was separated by 1 to 2 feet and approximately 7 to 8 feet back from the projected images.

Judges were each provided with an independent scoring pad which was wired directly to the club's computer based scoring system.

Projectionist and Score Keeper table was situated behind the judges with the viewing audience to the left and right of the table.
